# **Program Requirements**

Applicants **must** meet the following requirements in order to be admitted to the Construction Program and/or Trades Awareness Skills and Knowledge (TASK) Program.

#### **Students must:**

- 1. be fifteen years of age, or older and currently enrolled in grade 10, 11 or 12.
- 2. have their parent's/guardian's written permission.
- 3. demonstrate an interest and a level of maturity suitable for a trades program and a work environment.
- 4. be able to make provisions for their own transportation to and from a work experience job site.

- 1. provide a resume

- 3. provide a copy of your most recent secondary school marks.
- 4. have your counsellor complete the Education Plan Form (see attached).

Applicants will be required to attend a short interview (10 - 15 minutes) with the program teacher and college instructor. Student will be contacted regarding times for the interview.
